**Main duties and responsibilities (working with central teams)**

- Build relationships with key stakeholders and networks within the region
- Host information sessions and take part in assessment centres
- Build relationships with potential apprenticeship schools within the region, undertaking school visits and hosting school information sessions and an induction for the apprenticeship schools within the region
- Host and lead the delivery of regional training events
- Lead regional leadership development adviser meetings and talent reviews, and quality assure leadership development advisers within the region
- Communicate with and manage a range of stakeholders including: advisors, headteachers, participants, leadership development advisers, government officials, education and leadership organisations
- Manage budgets and resources cost-effectively, to maximise use of limited resources
- Contribute to programme management through planning, status reporting, risk and issue monitoring and resolution and delivery against plan and KPIs
- Coach to up to 6 participants within the region (under a separate leadership development adviser contract)

**Requirements**

The role requires senior level candidates who have sound knowledge of the UK education sector, policy and stakeholders, as well as experience of leadership development. The ability to establish personal credibility and influence is critical to the role. Previous experience in a front-line leadership role, involving managing and developing a team, is essential; some experience as a headteacher would be beneficial.
